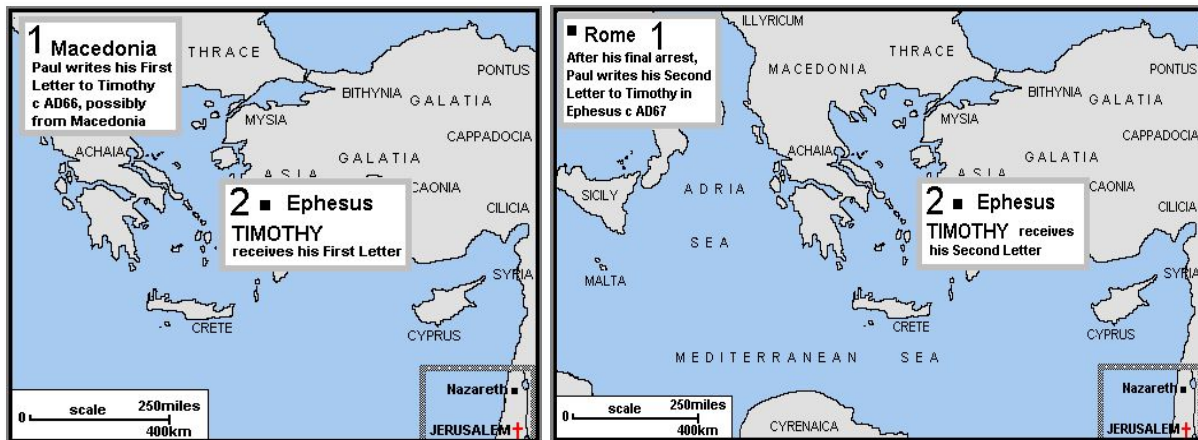


Pastoral Letters Study: I & II Timothy & Titus

(Jan-March, 2021)

Timothy

Timothy was raised in Lystra by a Jewish mother, Eunice, and grandmother, Lois, who had become believers. His father was a Greek. Paul met him during his second missionary journey and he became Paul's companion and co-worker along with Silas. He was compelled to become circumcised so as to not give the Jews reason to complain. Paul describes him as his "beloved and faithful son in the Lord", "Timothy my true child in faith"; and as "Timothy my beloved child." He was with Paul during his first Roman imprisonment (1:1 of prison letters). Afterwards, he was sent to Ephesus to evangelize and establish elders in the churches in Asia Minor. The second letter to Timothy asks him to come visit Paul before his death.

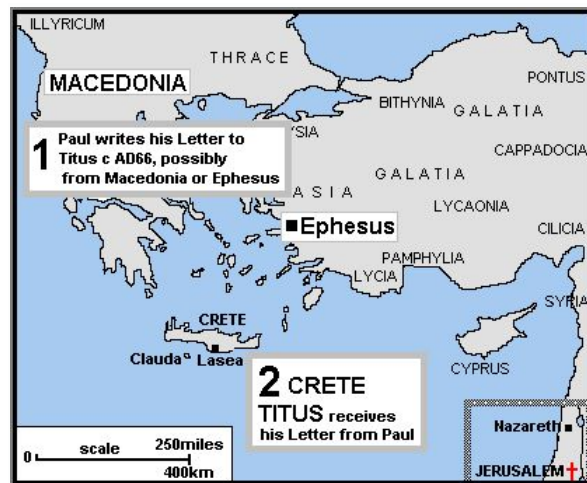

Titus

A Greek Christian, one of Paul's intimate friends, his companion in some of his apostolic journeys, and one of his assistants in Christian work. His name does not occur in the Acts but is the obvious topic of discussion in Acts 15:2 as we later find out in Gal 2:1-6. Paul calls him "my true child after a common faith". In his early ministry he was sent by Paul to work with the church at Corinth and his name is mentioned 8 times in Paul's second letter to that congregation. After Paul's release from his first Roman imprisonment he apparently traveled to the island of Crete and left Titus there to evangelize and establish elders in the congregations there.
